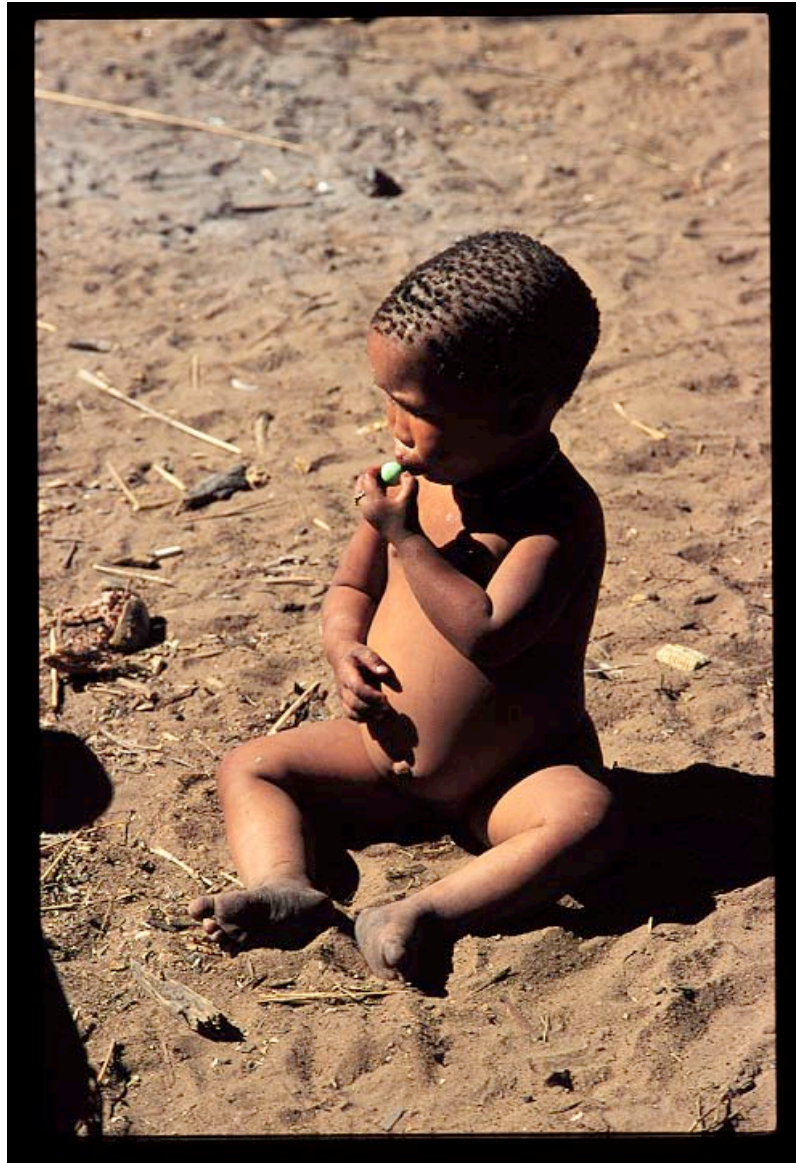

## THE BIRTH PLACE OF PILGRIM SOCIETY

More than a decade ago, a young student was searching for answers in the heart of Africa. In what some people call the cradle of humanity, Sebastian found his mission in life through his connection with the San people. They adopted him in 1998 as a tribesman and in turn he became a world spokesman for their plight.

Since 1995, Sebastian has been in the Kalahari 18 times, working for the protection of the San people by implementing projects such as water systems powered by solar technology, orphanage care, medical care and education.



## **BUILDING SOMETHING TOGETHER**

### **SOLAR POWERED WATER SYSTEMS IN THE HEART OF THE DESERT.**

Paradoxically, the Kalahari Desert has the largest underground lake in the world, only 200 feet below the ground surface. Pilgrim Society has developed solutions for bringing water from that depth using Siemens technology. This technology is entirely pollution free, obviously renewable, and free for the San people.



### **Kalahari Desert**

1. First Program designed to improve the life and culture of the San people. This means we will have a property with a hospital, a school, grades K-12, an orphanage for 100 children, a farm, and a workshop to teach young people practical skills.
2. 100 solar powered water systems for 200 villages. This project will provide water for all the villages in the Kalahari Desert including Namibia and Botswana.
3. Food supplies, blankets and bare necessities for the villages in the Kalahari.
