SCHOOL FOR THE REMOTE, ROMANIA

In January 2007, Pilgrim Society inaugurated the Remote Training Center in the northern mountains of Romania. A property of 10 hectares was donated for this purpose and a building erected to serve this purpose.

18 Students from 8 countries have been registered to begin classes in Remote tribes training. The course lasts 6 months, at the end of which the students will be sent to the Kalahari, Amazon, Congo, Vanuatu and Arctic to serve for a year. This is the result of a tremendous effort by a large number of people from around the globe. The inauguration was a success with 1200 participants from all over the world. Everyone, without exception, considered this project a triumph of a vision that will enable Pilgrim Society to reach new cultures and work for their preservation and development.
