## PILGRIM SOCIETY REACHES OCEANIA

The Vanuatu Group contains over 80 islands. The population is dominantly Melanesian with a small Polynesian population on some of the islands.

Many of these islands are reachable only by boat. This project is undertaken by Christian Tirtirau, the skipper of Nerissa K, a 32 foot sailing vessel that has crossed the Pacific Ocean since April 15th, 2007 to reach some of the most remote islands in the South Pacific. The main objective is to reach populations that cannot be reached by any other conventional means. Deep in the highlands of these volcanic islands, there are communities that are untouched by civilization to this day. Pilgrim Society will protect their old ways of living while offering support in several areas.
